Jon has mentored over 30 junior researchers and he is currently supervising over 20 PhD students and early career academics.

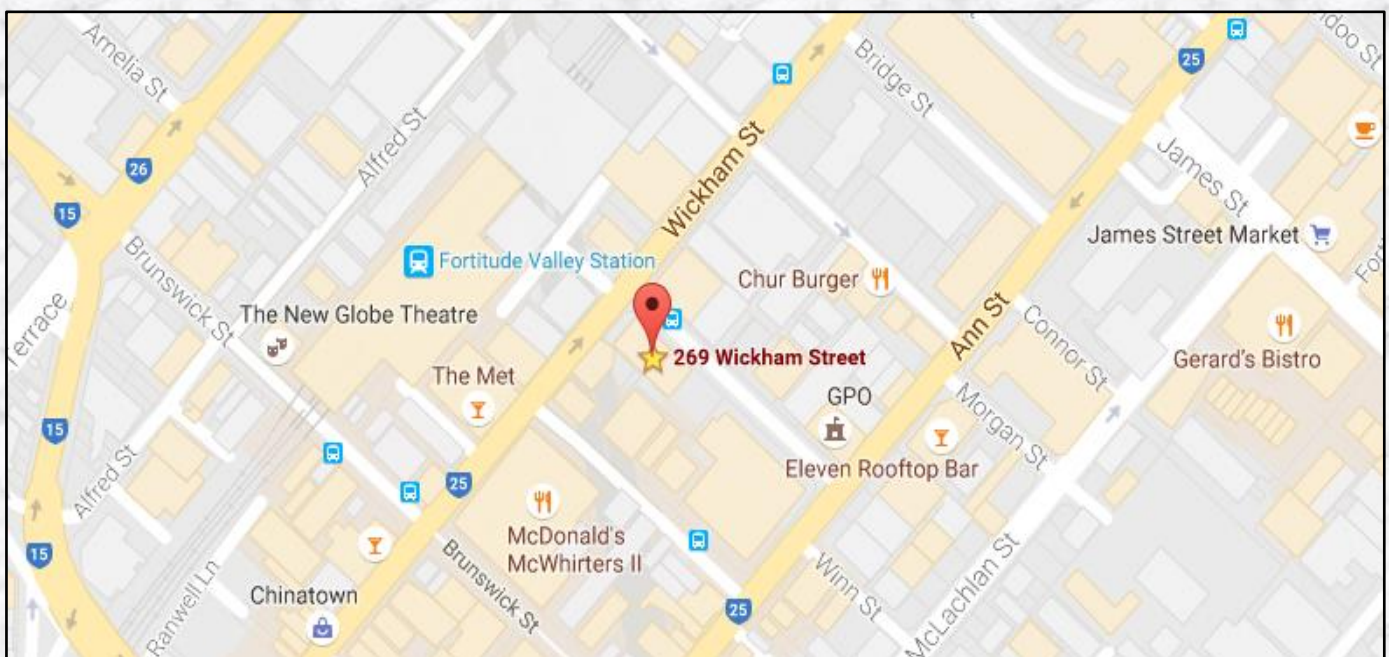
